The saying "Man is caught by what he chases" is similar to our Lord's exhortation that we should seek eternal treasures rather than temporal fortunes. This adage was illustrated in two stories told by Donald Ewing, a preacher in New England: A man entered the business world with only a handful of change and a fierce determination to become wealthy. After much hard work, he was a success—and the richest man in his community. He was honored publicly for donating a beautiful park to his town. But his unscrupulous business methods had left him with no genuine friends. When he went to the hospital with a terminal illness, he received few visitors. In the end, his money didn't gain for him the close relationships for which he longed. He died knowing neither friends nor the Lord. In contrast was the story about his own mother. She had been baptized as a youth and had made God's will her delight. When she was 91, she went to the hospital with several serious physical problems. A doctor tried to cheer her up by saying, "Now don't worry you're going to be home in a few days." She replied brightly, "Oh, I know that. I just don't know which home." Throughout her lifetime she pursued heavenly riches and had been so captured by them that she eagerly anticipated going to be with the Lord
