MINISTRY HIGHLIGHT: NATHAN JORGENSON

*The temple was completed on the third day of
the month Adar, in the sixth year of the reign of
King Darius. Ezra 6:15*

How many people, I wonder, fall short of
reaching their goal because they become weary
and discouraged? How many times do we give
up, perhaps unaware that success was within
reach had we just kept going? I would suppose
that it happens more often than we would like to
admit. And it is a tragedy—especially when this
happens while in the service of the Lord.

Zerubbabel and his workers were faced with
constant delays and discouragements in the
rebuilding of the Temple. How many times they
must have wanted to quit. How easy it would
have been just to give up. Yet they knew that the
Lord God had ordered the rebuilding of His
house, and this gave them the confidence to go
on.

I know the following is sort of silly, but it does
convey a lesson about the reward of
perseverance:

And bade his friend a sad adieu.
